Amenities Area

The Amenities Area is available to riders which includes the showers, toilets, laundry, BBQ and heated swimming pool. Please do not use the Fire Pit if there is a total fire ban.

Please ensure all areas, particularly the BBQ Areas are cleaned before departures.

Please note: no glasses or crockery is permitted at the Swimming Pool.

The Swimming Pool is open from 8.00am to 8.00pm.

Stables

All Competition Stables have rubber-lined floors. Some Competition Stables feature automatic waterers and feed bins however please bring a water and feed bucket in case your stable is not fitted. There are taps in each row of the stables for your convenience.

Please use the stable number allocated to you by the Organiser.

Shavings – It is not permitted to bring your own shavings or stable bedding. Please purchase Willinga Park bales of shavings from the organiser. All bales of shavings will be delivered to your stable number as per the shavings order received from the event organiser.

All stables must be completely cleaned out on departures with all shavings and manure moved to the Manure Pit situated near the wash bays. Stables should be swept clean.

Manure is not to be left in the wheelie bins at the stables – please use the Manure Pits.

No hoof black can be used on the bitumen roads or outside the stables on any concrete surface. This will also incur a \$200.00 stable bond fee.

Arenas and Horse Access

The Showjumping Arena is available for your event from Tuesday 24 February to Sunday 1 March 2026. Manure scoops and wheelie bins are located at each arena – please be mindful and pick up manure.

All riders must wear helmets when riding.

Speed limit

The speed limit around the park and stables is 10km per hour. For safety reasons please adhere to the speed limit.

WIFI

Basic WIFI is available in some parts of the park. A WIFI will be available from the Competition Office to locate spots for best reception.

Tick Awareness

The NSW South Coast is currently in tick season, so we encourage you to be mindful when spending time outdoors. Consider wearing protective clothing and checking yourself, your family, and pets for ticks after walking through grassy or wooded areas.

While dogs are not permitted to stay in the Pavilions, we understand that friends or family visiting you during the day may bring their dogs on site. If this is the case, please ensure their dogs are on a tick preventive plan, always on a lead, and under your supervision while on the property.

Snake and Wildlife Awareness

Snakes are a natural part of our environment, and while they are generally shy and avoid human interaction, they can occasionally be encountered, especially in warmer weather. If you plan to walk or explore the grounds, please stay on designated paths and remain vigilant.

You may also encounter goannas, lizards and kangaroos, we ask you to please not disturb them and let them move on peacefully.

Dogs are welcome, however must be always kept on a lead.
